

**Jackson County School District Resiliency,
Substance Use and Abuse, and Child
Trafficking Prevention Education
Implementation Plan**

(Grades 6-12)



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Curriculum Overview

1. Jackson County School District has chosen to partner with an online internet based comprehensive resiliency, character development, and mental health program through Imagine Learning, LLC in cooperation with Purpose Prep. The curriculum meets the ruling beyond the minimum requirement of instruction with course specification per grade that is developmentally appropriate and skill building, which advances each year with student progression. The curriculum will include the following components as required by the State Board of Education:

1. Strategies specific to demonstrating resiliency through adversity, including the benefits of service to the community through volunteerism.
2. Life skills that build confidence, support mental and emotional health, and enable students to overcome challenges, including:
 - a. Empathy, resiliency, perseverance, grit, gratitude, and honesty;
 - b. Critical thinking, problem solving, and responsible decision-making;
 - c. Self-awareness and self-management;
 - d. Mentorship, leadership, and citizenship;
3. Recognition of signs and symptoms of mental health concerns.
4. Strategies to support a peer, friend, or family member through adversity.
5. Prevention of suicide.
6. Prevention of the abuse of and addiction to alcohol, nicotine, and drugs.
7. Awareness of local school and community resources and the process for accessing assistance.
8. Substance Use and Abuse Health Education.

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9. Prevention of Child Sexual Abuse, Exploitation, and Human Trafficking.
10. Teen dating violence and Abuse Prevention (Grades 7-12).
11. Benefits of Sexual Abstinence & Consequences of Teenage Pregnancy.
12. Prevention of mental health disorders.
13. Social, emotional, and physical effects of social media, including addiction.

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Instructional Delivery

The Imagine Learning, LLC/Purpose Prep 6th-12th grade comprehensive resiliency curriculum will be delivered in an online internet based comprehensive program through Imagine Learning in cooperation with Purpose Prep. The curriculum has course specifications per grade that are developmentally appropriate. Instruction will be delivered in the following courses:

*Students in upper grade levels taking dual enrollment/early admit courses will still be required to complete the Resiliency, Substance Use and Abuse, and Child Trafficking Prevention Education curriculum requirements via our online internet based comprehensive program through Imagine Learning, LLC in cooperation with Purpose Prep.

1. The instructors designated to assist with the Jackson County School District comprehensive resiliency curriculum are provided through the online internet based program through Imagine Learning, LLC in cooperation with Purpose Prep.
2. Oversight and implementation of the comprehensive resiliency curriculum will be conducted by the Director of Safety, Director of K-12 Programs and MIS, and the Mental Health Administrator for Jackson County School District. The combined qualifications of the three staff are as follows:

Individualized tracking of student progress through the modules and completion of instruction will be accomplished through the individualized progressive tracking of module completion within the online platform.
