Health Program Services

POLICY:

Nutritional services are implemented to ensure that children receive culturally and developmentally appropriate meals, including children with special dietary needs and/or disabilities.

• This policy relates to Head Start Performance Standard 1302.44 (a)

PROCEDURE:

- 1. All foods provided to students must comply with Head Start guidelines and licensing regulations.
- 2. The Grantee's food service provider will provide breakfast, lunch, and a snack for all students. A monthly menu will be provided to all classrooms and families.
- **3.** Any food for parties and/or celebrations-must be store-bought, pre-packaged, and unopened. will be provided by the Jackson County Early Childhood Program.
- 4. Foods required for nutritional activities that support the curriculum will be provided by the program as scheduled. Téaching staff may purchase any additional food items they would like to use to enhance the current lesson/curriculum.
